The Indus Hospital, Al-Ghazi Trust Campus, Bhong, Rahim Yar Khan. 40 bed general hospital with a special focus on maternal and neonatal healthcare services.

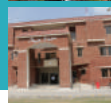

Tehsil Headquarter Hospital Manawan, Lahore. 100 bed multidisciplinary general hospital.



Tehsil Headquarter Hospital Sabzazar, Lahore. 100 bed general hospital with a special focus on maternal, neonatal and pediatric healthcare services.



Tehsil Headquarter Hospital Raiwand, Lahore. 60 bed general hospital being expanded to 100 beds.



Recep Tayyip Erdogan Hospital, Muzaffargarh. 126 bed general hospital with a special focus on maternal and neonatal healthcare services. The hospital is being expanded to 500 beds.



Multan Institute of Kidney Diseases, Multan. 150 bed hospital specializing in Urology and Nephrology services.



District Headquarter Hospital, Badin. 190 bed multidisciplinary general hospital.

PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAMS

In addition to hospital based programs, The Indus Health Network is reaching out to communities through disease based programs and through primary care. Outreach programs are managed through Global Health Directorate of IHN.

Disease Based Programs

Disease Based Programs are funded through Global Fund for the following diseases and are currently operational in 41 districts across Pakistan.

- MDR - TB Program (AaoTB Mitao)
- Malaria Program
- HIV Program

Primary Care Programs

Indus Health Network's strategy is to lessen the healthcare burden on tertiary hospitals by providing basic treatment through primary healthcare units. IHN has established family medicine clinics in order to reach out to people residing in small towns and cities.

CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE



Physical Rehabilitation Center
Physical Rehabilitation Center provides orthotic and prosthetic limbs to patients to enable them to walk again. Around 5,975 patients have been provided with prosthetic & orthotic devices.



Blood Center
It is the first international standard blood center in Pakistan that serves to promote voluntary blood donation. As of December 2017, around 23,394 donations were received from blood donors from Karachi.
